

ORCACON PERMISSION SLIP FOR MINORS

OrcaCon's Rules for Minors:

A minor as defined by the State of Washington is any child* under the age of 18. A parent, legal guardian, or an individual designated by the parent or legal guardian, must be on-site when the minor is on-site. Minors must have a permission slip on file with Registration (See Section Below) signed by a parent or legal guardian.

In the event that the parent or legal guardian will not be on-site during the convention, the parent or guardian must designate a person who will be on-site and is to be responsible for the minor. This person must be an attendee of the convention.
